PROGRAM 1: KHAMMAM DISTRICT HEAD QUARTERS

Poster Release by Additional DCP:

On the occasion of World Day Against Trafficking In Persons (30th July), the organization was organised a poster release program on 29-07-2024 at Khammam commissionarate. The thematic poster was released on the hands of honorable Sri. Naresh Kumar garu, Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police(Admin). After that, he was addressed about present trends of human trafficking, role of different departments like Police, Labour, WCD and NGOs and community to eliminate the human trafficking in the district. In this program Sri. Balaji Ci, AHTU, Mr. Narasimha Rao, AHTU members, P S S Hari Prasada Rao, AID Director, K. Srinivas, V. Rajesh District program coordinators of Khammam and Bhadradri and B. Kutumba Rao, counselor, AID was attended.

INTRODUCTION: AID organization was conducted the awareness program at Sri Vidya College, Mamillagudem, Khammam

Participants: Youth, Girls and Boys from college and others. Nearly 200 members were participated in the programs. For the program we invited the Resource persons from Mr. Narasimha Rao of Anti Human Trafficking Unit, Khammam, Mrs. Ramadevi of District Legal Services Authority, Mr. Lingaiah of Child Welfare Committee, Mr. Sridhar College Management, Mrs. Srilatha, Srividya College and Mr. P S S Hari Prasada Rao Director attended as guests.

In the program the guests were addressed as follows...

Mr PSS Hari Prasada Rao , Director AID addressed the gathering on Right to Education act-2009, promoting of Secondary Education, present situation of dropouts in the district, role of NGOs to

reduce the drop outrate. Child marriages are also one of the reason for trafficking the children and women. Traffickers target the single women, home makers who wishes to earn money for their family from home etc., All the above situatons and reasons causes for trafficking. So we should be awre of traffickers and must use toll free numbers in emergency like dial 100, 1098 or emergency response number 112. And also explained the importance of educate the neighbours on laws and roles and



responsibilities of a citizen for eliminating human trafficking through group discussions, mouth to mouth propaganda, act as informers to the line departments and protection of citizens in trafficking mafias.

Mr D Lingaiah member CWC spoke on Child labour act, POCSO act and role of Child Welfare



Committee for care and protection of children in the district. He continued that most of the children are using mobile phone for a long time and neglecting their studies. After lockdown it was incressed a lot. He was explained how this mobile addiction can damage their brain function, becoming fatty, psychological and physical cahneges, depression, suicide attempts, online gaming

frauds, money loss etc., He concluded that children must use their rights like right to live, right to protect, right to develop and right to paricipate in a proper way and should become a good citizen in the society and work towards a better society.

Ms Ramadevi, Panel Advocate, DLSA, Khammam addressed on the services provided by DLSA to

children like "Free Legal Aid to children", PARA legal volunteers services, compansation to POCSO victims, free legal aid defence counsel services to their families who's parents are in prision, immediate relief to bonded labour children and family, acid victims, SC/ST attracity victims etc., She was also explained in detailed note on POCSO act-2012, NLSA, SLSA, DLSA and Mandal Legal Services Committees.



Mr Narasimha Rao, AHTU, Khammam explained about how human trafficking happening aroud us,



ITPA act, impact of social media in trafficking persons, preventive methods to be followed in facebook, whats app, Instagram and twitter etc. He gave some good exaples of trafficking case rigisterd so far In the district. Mainly, traffickers can traffick people for four reasons like sexual exlpoitation, using them as domestic labour, bonded laobur and most imortantly organ selling. No one or no mechine can make blood and skin in this world except from human being. All we don't know that who is a

trafficker and who is not, anybody can do untill you realize that you were trafficked. So all you must be care ful about trafficking and inform to police personnel if you suspect any one.

Conclusion: the program run upto 2 and half hours and nearly 200 children got aware about human trafficking. The college management and lectures and children thanked AID for conducting such a good program in their college.




PROGRAM 4: WYRA MANDAL:


PROGRAM 5: TIRUMALAYAPALEM MANDAL:
