Minority Education Program

ASHA KIRAN SEVA SANSTHAN always focus on development of weaker section of community it its operational area. The organization took initiatives for education program of minorities. Staff and volunteers visited in minority area and conducted meetings with minority community and motivated them for sending their children to schools. School Management committees also contacted and held meetings with them for mobilizing minority community so that parents could be aware on their children's education.

Skill Development

Youths are the backbone of the society and making them skilled training is required. **ASHA KIRAN SEVA SANSTHAN** organized skill development training among youths on Mobile repairing. There were 53 students trained under skill development training. This program will enhance the knowledge and skill among youths for employability.

Computer Training Program

Computer literacy has become vital tool in the digital era and its presence is everywhere in day-to-day life. Rural and poor boys and girls have a few opportunities to go through in computer literacy program. **ASHA KIRAN SEVA SANSTHAN** organised computer training program for them so that they could learn computers and become employable wherever any opportunity comes to them. There were 112 boys and girls got trained in computer.

Agriculture Awareness Program

The state like Jharkhand has the worst profile in terms of agriculture & Horticulture practiced by the rural population for their survival. Lack of cost effective farming system, lack of improved skills and irrigations facilities from agriculture & Horticulture activities have created mass unemployment problem in the entire state. **ASHA KIRAN SEVA SANSTHAN** gives priority to create better and sustainable Livelihood/self- employment opportunities by inducing improved farming skills and techniques on among rural masses residing in the rural pocket of its operational areas of **Bokaro**.

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME.

Local community meetings were organized in **Bokaro** District Area under support of local volunteers and social activists and Advantages of clean environment with disadvantages of pollution were made acquainted to them. They were activated to clean solid & liquid wastes and water bodies and to use smokeless stores. They were also activated for plantation works to effect better environment atmosphere.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME

Women's empowerment is the process of empowering women. Empowerment can be defined in many ways, however, when talking about women's empowerment, empowerment means accepting and allowing people (women) who are on the outside of the decision-making process into it. Many people think that the days of woman fighting for rights are over but those people are wrong because 1 out of every 3 women has been sexually harassed or cat called in public by random men they don't know. Every day women are put down and told how to act and that they were asking for it if you wear that making woman feels that it is their fault, it is not.

Covid-19 Awareness Program

Self Help Groups are small groups of people facing similar problems. The members of the group help each other to solve their problems. A reasonably educated but helpful local person takes the lead in mobilizing these people to form a group. SHG is an important aspect of women empowerment. It is the one of the best mean to organize women on common platform to make them familiar with the strength of collective action. 50 SHGs of most deprived and underprivileged category of women's group has been formed in **rural pocket areas of Bokaro Districts, Jharkhand**. SHG Group management and strengthening program was organized this year in 2 different rural pockets in our project area. These women SHGs group members belong to ST, SC and OBC Category.

Schedule of the Programs/ Events Organized during the year are as follows:

awareness building have been done on saving and Credit, Bank inclusions, Livelihood, Income generation, Immunization, Health and Hygiene, Educations, etc among 120 SHG members to build-up their skills of better SHG management. All sort of information and inputs are being delivered to them to promote their self-esteem, self-respect and sustainability along with socio-economic empowerment.
