About Us:

Bijapur Integrated Rural Development Society (BIRDS) was established on 2nd October 1989 on the auspicious day of Gandhi Jayanti committed to work on ideals of Mahatma Gandhi. It was registered on 1st February 1990 under Karnataka Society Registration act 1960. It is a non-profit, on political and non-sectarian voluntary organization. It is a developmental organization working with vulnerable target group of families especially landless, small and marginal farmers, disable and physically challenged children's, socio-economic issues of the women, upliftment of SC, ST and rural poor through diversified developmental activities.

Initially, we have focused on resettlement and rehabilitation (R&R) of poor people who were dislocated due to the building of Krishna water reservoir in Narayanpur village, Ever since our initial movement, BIRDS Have been working in selected backward Taluks of Bagalkot, Bijapur, Dharawad, Kodagu, Gulbarga, Haveri, Belgaum, Koppal & Yadgiri Districts of Karnataka State. "Awareness through Education" has become the theme of all our Programme.

OUR APPROACH

Children are with disabilities:

Identifying children with developmental disorders is our priority as mainutrition; marriage within families is very prevalent in our operational area. Our interventions involve:

- -Basic Survey and screening process to identify children with developmental disabilities at an early stage
- Intervention centre, volunteers who are expert in the field handling children with Delay Development provide training to children as well to their families

Many children have been restored back to health and re-integrated into mainstream of the society



Women Empowerment:

There are many ways to empower women, and we have chosen to impart digital literacy to women from rural areas as they were ignorant about latest technologies.

-we have trained 213 Saathis, who will in turn reach out to rural women and provide digital literacy trainings they also teach them utilizing smart phones and internet for their livelihood promotion.



Farmer's welfare:

Watershed Development programme is implemented in collaboration with Agriculture department, Government of Karnataka, covering many villages benefitting farming communities as well as women. This has helped them to understand the importance of conserving soil and water resources to increase crop productivity. Following our interventions, we have observed:

-Improved soil and water resources Prevention of top-soil erosion



Livelihood:

We Identify illiterate adult populations in both rural and urban slum areas and increase their change of getting better employment opportunities through vocational trainings. We have approach:

- -Change attitudes and promote support for carers, their families and communities, empowering them towards better health, wellbeing and economic security.
- -Inspire systemic change in the government, private and third sectors so they recognize and respond to the needs of carers.



Literacy Program:

- -10 illiterate persons are assigned to one trained volunteer
- Four programmes implemented to cover huge population in different locations
- Vocational training is provided at respective Grama Panchayat regions.
