About us

CHILD VOICE is a registered nonprofit organization established in 2011 in order to protect vulnerable children from all forms of abuse and exploitation. The organization is committed for the well-being of all children through community support, involving relevant stakeholders towards a sustainable intervention in an ongoing process. The organization registered in Dindigul, Tamilnadu.

Child voice is guided by a strong board that governs the functioning of the activities of the organization. Child Voice continues to work with eradicate child labors, mainstreaming school dropouts, prevention of child marriages, children with health and nutrition issues, mitigation of adolescent girls at risk, young workers, rescue and rehabilitate bonded labour, modern slavery and child trafficking, ensure safe and secure the children abused either sexually / any other abuses. Child Voice works on the principle that all children are equal and must be given equal opportunities. Our activities are carried out by a team of 7 full time staff and 30 part time staff.

The target area of the organization is four blocks Palani, Dindigul, Kodaikanal and Nilakottai of Dindigul District in which Child Voice is working in 30 villages of 12 Panchayets in Nilakottai block to eradicate all forms of modern slavery and in Kodaikanal block, Perungadu a hilly remote hamlet is paid much attention in all respects for the welfare and development of tribal children, because 14 km walking is only source to reach the hamlet.

- Establishing sustainable communities, comprising of various stakeholders to positively respond to the inevitable need for care and protection of vulnerable children
- Empowering underprivileged children through community sensitization and mobilization around key issues of child rights and protection by their participation.
- Assertion of comprehensive rights of children and to bring policy level changes through effective lobbying, advocacy, networking and campaign strategies.

Objectives

- To identify and map school dropout children, runaway children, street children, children at risk and child labouers in the operational areas of Dindigul, Palani and Kodaikanal.
- To protect school dropout children, runaway children, street children and child labours from economic exploitation and protect them against all forms of abuse and discrimination.
- To facilitate and to create opportunities for their skill development and economic independence by enhancing them through capacity building programs enabling them to be dignified and resourceful citizen.
- To equip the children with life skills for living in harmony with other children and to facilitate their learning opportunities and enhancing their capacity towards increasing future employment opportunities.

- To create opportunities for children to showcase their talent and to identify and promote leadership qualities and enabling increased child participation through collective forum.
- To empower children sangams and federation to identify child rights violations and enabling them to address the issue by themselves and to ascertain their rights.
- To promote gender equity and equality in schools and communities.
- To join hands with civil society organizations in campaigns and solidarity actions for influencing policy level changes.

- To establish Child Voice as resource organizations in the field of child rights and effectively carry put advocacy and lobbying both at micro and macro level jobs.

Dear All,

In the year 2019 -2020, Child voice carried out various activities in the field. We are working in 30 village covered by nilakottai block in dindigul district with the support of freedom fund UK. In order to empowering the community to protect girls at risk, we run community resources centers, conduct village level child protection committee, interface meetings, organizing events for important days, rescusing and rehabilitating the children at risk, providing counselling services to needy people especially for affected children, adolescent group and their families, assisting community people to get legal support and benefits from the governments etc...

In the month of March 2020, the entire world was collapsed with COVID-19 hit and lockdown was announced in tamilnadu. It affected our programme activities in our working villages and it created a massive damage in the lives of our beneficiaries in our target areas. In that difficult situations, with the support of local sponsors we were able to provide supplementary nutrition to children and adolescent group members as well as kabasura kudineer, arsenic album tablets to community people for increasing their immune systems to fight against Corona Virus. We were able to complete the building of child friendly toilet along with incinerator in government kallar higher secondary school in anaipatty and wall painting was done in government girls higher secondary school in dindigul with the support of wind trust Chennai through thalapakatty CSR project.

Everything was possible with the support of our donors Freedom Fund UK, Katradi NGO and tireless works of ours staff members. I take this opportunity to thank you all for their generous contribution and kind support. I sincerely thank our organization board members, MLA, government officials, district legal service authority, block legal service authority panchayat leaders, panchayat ward members, clerks, governments departments like police, taluk office, village administrative office, members of community level groups for their continuous support in the smooth implementation of the programme activities.

... Community Resource Centers ...

Child Voice runs Community Resource Centers for vulnerable children in 30 working villages in Nilakottai Block and the following activities are being undertaken regularly for children by the part time -facilitator appointed in each village. Games, Storytelling, Homework process, General knowledge updating, Talent acquisition, and Celebration of Important days are the main activities of CRC. Totally 1212 Children were benefited from this program.



...Adolescent Action Groups (AAG)... And

...Adolescent Boys Group (ABG)...

Adolescent Action Group (AAG)and Adolescent Boys Groups(ABG) are formed in 30 villages in Nilakottai block where Child Voice is operating is project .Totally ,44 AAG and 30 ABG are formed and functioning well in the community under the support and guidance of child voice .The meeting of AAG were conducted 4 times in a month and ABG meetings are conducted 2 times in a month .The primary objective of these group is to finding out the solution to the problems and issues faced by adolescent group in the village /school and in the community .





Call me Priya is a film based curriculum shown to adolescent girls and boys, school teachers and it spoke about the issue faced by an adolescent girl who is working in a mill after discontinuing her studies due to the poverty situation of her family. This short film sensitized many boys & girls, teachers and parents to give important to children's education and how they will face the issues and challenges when they go for work at early stages.

Mental health service and counseling also were provided to the adolescent boys and girls based on the issues. Individual counseling and group counseling process were carried out by the facilitators among the young people in 30 villages covered by Child Voice in Nilakottai Block.

Prevention of children marriage in the community is the main activity of this group and sensitized the community people on consequences of child marriage by conducting awareness programs and through regular group meetings. Prevention of Drugs usage among young people especially among the boys group were sensitized by group meetings and awareness programs.

Sports events were conducted for adolescent boys and girls in each villages and conducted block level sports events to motivate the sport talents of young people.

...Community Support Groups...

Community support group is a forum of people formed and functioning in 30 working village in Nilakottai block covered by Child Voice .It meets twice in a month and discuss about the problems of children, adolescent group and women and find out the solutions at village level. The members of the community group also involved in the programs /activities undertaken by Child Voice in the target villages .They are trained and motivated to work as a collective group to solve the issues of their villages by coming forward together toward any common issues.

...Interface meetings...

Interface meetings were conducted in the following areas to discuss about the needs and issues of the village with respective officers from Panchayats and Government departments.

Panchayat level interface meeting:

19.7.2019-Kullankundu panchayat conducted the Interface meeting Deputy BDO of Nilakottai block was presided over the meeting .VAO, Community support members, Facilitators from Child Voice were present in the meeting and discussed the needs and problems of the villages which comes under Kullalakundu Panchayat.

25.7.2019-Nuthalapuram Panchayat conducted interface meeting in Thummalapaty Village .School Head Master Indirani of Thummalapatty Middle school ,Ex-President of Nuthalapuram Panchayat Mr.Selvaraj Community Support Group members ,Facilitators and FCos of Child Voice were represented in the meeting and raised the concern of the villages development which are coming under Nuthalapuram Panchayat.

Block level Interface meeting:

7.11.2029-Block level Interface meeting was conducted in Nilakottai BDO office .Block development officer was presiding over the meeting Panchayat clerks from Kullakundu ,Pillyarnatham,Kottur and Sivanaganpuram panchayat were attended this meeting .ICDS officer Mrs.Revathi .Child Line department representatives ,Community support group members ,Facilitators ,FCos ,programme manager of Child Voice were also participated in this meeting and discussed about the issues at Block level department wise. The main objective of this meeting was to bring out the Government girls higher secondary school in Nilakottai Block.

...VLCPC meetings...

Village Level Child Protection Committee meeting was organized and conducted in Kullakundu, Thoppupatty, Ethilodu, Kodankinayakanpatty Veelinayakanpatty, Kullichettipatty, Pillayarnatham panchayats on 10.7.2019.

Respective Panchayat Clerks, Anaganwadi teachers, BDO ,VAO ,School Head masters ,Village Health Nurses ,Sanitary workers ,Community Support Group members ,Facilitators ,FCos ,Manager and Program Director of Child Voice were participated and discussed the points to ensure the safety of children in each panchayats.

...Health Camps & Follow up...

Health camps were conducted in the target working villages of Child Voice in association with Santhiya Hospital and Saravana Hospital, Madurai.

7.7.2019 -Health camp conducted in Thoppupatty village in association with Saravana hospital, Madurai. The doctors team examined the health problems of adolescent girls and boys as well as young workers who are working in spinning /textile mills and garments.

25.8.2019-Health camp conducted in Veelinayakanpatty village in association with Santhiya Hospital, Madurai. The doctor's team examined the health problems of adolescent girls and boys as well as young workers who are working in spinning /textile mills and garments.

15.9.2019-Health camp conducted in Aavarampatty village in association with Santhiya Hospital, Madurai. The doctor's team examined the health problems of adolescent girls and boys as well as young workers who are working in spinning /textile mills and garments. After the health checkup, the details like Height, weight and other health issues found in health checkup were recorded in health card for further follow up process.

...Skill Net meeting...

Skill net meeting was conducted in BDO office, Nilakottai on the following dates -19.5.2019, 24.5.2020 and 6.11.2019.Mr.S.Anna durai, managing trustee of Child Voice Conducted the skill net meeting .Totally 55 people from 30 villages were participated and learnt the business skills and how to do marketing with an innovation.

9.12.2019 -Skill net meeting was conducted in Child Voice Office, Nilakottai. Totally, 35 people from 30 villages were took part in this meeting .Mrs.Divya, Programme Officer of FVTRS, Bangalore was the resource person to this meeting and she had given the special talk on entrepreneurship skills.

Sports meet

23.6.2019-Child Voice conducted traditional games (Parampariya Villaiyattukal) in every village where it operates the project especially for young workers, adolescent groups in Nilakottai block. Children and young people from each village were actively participated in this sports event. Mr. Karumalaipandiyan, Secretary of Nadar school, Nilakottai, Mr. Mathavan ,Secretary from Rotary Club ,Batlagundu,Dr.Vanithamani Trustee of Child Voice, Mr.S. Annadurai, Managing trustee of Child Voice were the chief quests of this event. All children who were participated in this event awarded with participant's certificates and those who participated and won in this event appreciated with prizes and certificates. FCos, Facilitators and Programme Manager of Child Voice had organized this event and facilitated the whole event.



24.12.2019- Cluster level Kabadi game was conducted for Adolescent girls group and Adolescent Boys group in Sirunayakanppaty village .Winners are awarded with prizes and certificates .Mr.S.Anna durai ,Managing trustee of Child Voice ,Mr. Ravi from Test Organization ,Virudhunagar were the chief and Special guest to this event .Facilitators ,FCos and Programme Manager were also took part in this event .

Cultural training meet

31.12.2019 -Cultural meet was organized at Karuppasamy temple in Nilakottai Block. Totally 30 Adolescent Action Group and Adolescent Boys Groups members were participated in this cultural training meet. Mr. Manimaran from Cultural troop came and trained the young girls and boys in awareness songs to prevent the child marriage and violence against children and women . As part of the training song compose , singing practice , voice modulation, body language and performing arts trainings were given to all the participants. Facilitators of child voice were also participated.









