# ACTIVITIES OF THE ORGANIZATION

# TAILORING TRAINING PROGRAMME

L.M.S. Charitable Trust has been focusing on empowerment of women are who are marginalized. A few developmental programmes such as tailoring training, social analysis training programmes were implemented in Bangalore. 75 women were benefited from these programmes. Some of them supported with placements and a few of them were linked with bank to take up self-employment.

#### **COVID-19 ACTIVITIES**

As you know that corona virus is an immediate threat to humanity and its spread speed is accelerating at a rapid pace. This communicable disease can be only be prevented by providing face masks, eye goggles and providing sanitizer. L.M.S. Charitable Trust is distributing face masks and sanitizers in our operational area to contain and fight corona virus.

#### EYE CAMP

L.M.S. Charitable Trust has carried out an eye camp at Kolar, Kolar District. It has helped 200 people to avail the benefits. 5 senior were supported with Cataract operation and also distributed with spectacles.

#### CANDLE MAKING

A training on vocational training was conducted and the women were motivated to undertake the training diligently and pursue a career thereafter. Besides this, awareness programs were conducted on various health issues with focus on HIV and AIDS. *Avenues for job placement were also identified in the garment sector*. The women were also offered skill training in Candle making.

#### HOUSEHOLD SURVEY ON SCHOOL DROPOUT CHILDREN

L.M.S. Charitable Trust has carried a household survey in K.R.Puram with the aim of re-enrolled the school dropout children into schools. Our organization has identified 225 children. Among them a few children were enrolled back into schools and a few children were referred to other NGOs for further rehabilitation.

# SHELTER FOR URBAN HOMELESS

L.M.S. Charitable Trust has been running a night shelter in Hoody Block, Bangalore and the centre has been providing accommodation to homeless during the nights. The building is being provided by the BBMP, Bangalore to cater our service to needy urban homeless people. The people who do not have dwelling place come to our centre in the night and we provide them Cots, beds, blankets etc. Around 30-35 urban homeless people taking shelter in the night.

In this reporting period the organization has progressed in its thematic lines and has established programmatic interventions in almost all the programme lines included in the vision and mission of the organization.

The organization is also grateful to its organizational staff members who provided their valuable and important cooperation and dedication for the success of the programmatic interventions. Without their dedication the achievements of the intervention of the reporting year could not be possible.


