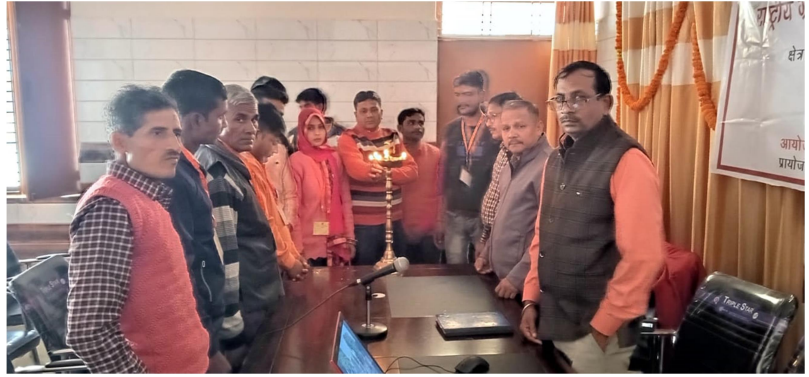
Educational Awareness Programs
