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In memoriam



Late NANJUNDAIAH **Founder of Nisarga Foundation** **01-Dec-1960 to 23-Dec-2021**

Though it's been one and half year since Mr. Nanjundaiah has passed away, his contributions to the field of social work especially towards the development of indigenous community is eternal. He was a generous and kind hearted person to quit his job 38 years ago in central silk board to fight for the livelihood and betterment of Adivasis who have been displaced from the forest. This is one of his greatest determinations that he has made after realizing Adivasis hardships and poverty. After the implementation of wildlife conversation Act 1972 and construction of Taraka and Nugu dam, 25 tribal hamlets were evicted from the forest without proper rehabilitation. At this time of crisis, he raised his voice against the situation created by the Government and came forward to create awareness about how to fight back against the Government for their rights.

As a result of displacement of the tribes, they started running out of money and work. Though, Adivasis had their own land, it was eventually encroached by land lords of the locality. Sri Nanjundaiah is very successful in giving land for more than 2000 tribal families in H D Kote from Government. He has helped more than 1500 tribal people to have their regular pension which was allotted exclusively for Adivasi people by Government.

He established NISARGA FOUNDATION in the year 1997 to protect Adivasi and to have food security for them. In 2006, Central Government of India enforced the Forest Rights Act and it was Sri Nanjundaiah's dream to get 10 acres of land for each family of Adivasis in H D Kote, under this Act. He always gave importance for children's education and health program. Education programs started with pre-primary schools in tribal hamlets, evening schools, school dropout Child labour school, CHILD Helpline program and malnutrition program. He was more ambitious in achieving tribal children's higher education in each tribal hamlet.

. While we are still mourning the passing of this great man, his vision, dedication and unconditional love that he had showed for the indigenous community in H D Kote always remind us the famous quote of a poet "I have promises to keep, miles to go before I sleep".

Message from the President



It is with great pleasure that I present Nisarga Foundation's Annual Report of the year 2022-23. This report shares the success story of Nisarga Foundation and the impact of our work on the communities we serve and our goals for the future. For over two and half decades, Nisarga Foundation has been working with indigenous communities in HD Kote taluk on various fronts, including health, education, agriculture, food security, sustainability, advocacy and women empowerment; impacting over 32,000 indigenous and marginalized people. I am happy to share that we have rescued 2465 children through our Child Helpline project, in partnership with Childline India Foundation and Women and Child Development Department, Government of India. Considering that malnutrition has long been a silent killer amongst indigenous communities, we have made significant progress through our Spirulina Supplement Programme by improving the health and nutrition levels of 850 malnourished children, pregnant women and lactating mothers with the help of Mission Inde, France. With the support of Azim Premji Foundation we were able to submit 804 IFR and 13 CFR applications and CFR GPS is done. Gramasabha members benefited with Gramasabha capacity building training, Govt schemes training, legal training and Sustainable harvesting training. I thank all our board and executive team members for their untiring efforts in taking our mission forward. I sincerely thank all donors from the bottom of my heart for their valuable support.

ABOUT NISARGA FOUNDATION

Nisarga Foundation is a non-profit, voluntary and registered organisation was founded in the year 1997 under the Indian Trust Act has set its goal to ensure the positive, socio-economic change of the indigenous communities and underprivileged, downtrodden and marginalized communities by taking up various initiatives. The organisation is situated in tribal taluk of Heggadadevana Kote of Mysore district in Karnataka. The organisation is headed by a Governing Body which comprises of seven members of repute. Based on a firm decision of the Governing Body, Nisarga Foundation since its inception has been working towards enhancing quality and dignity of life in tribal community in and around Heggadadevana Kote.

Mr.Prabhu, Secretary and Executive Director of Nisarga Foundation, who is conferred with the responsibility of leading the organisation, is a dedicated person working towards tribal issues. He has been working with the indigenous communities in the Taluk since 15 years. His involvement with the communities, over a period of time, has helped him in attaining immense knowledge about the life oftribals, their socio economic problems and their culture. He has been part of several networks where tribals have got an opportunity to self-rule. Nisarga Foundation has been a part of several networks such as Adivasi Solidarity Council, Tribal Joint Action-Karnataka, Federation of Voluntary Organisations for Rural Development- Karnataka (FEVORD-K), Mythri, National Adivasi Council for Development of Indigenous People (NACDIP) and Indian Social Action Forum (INSAF).

Moreover, various programs are chalked out and executed by Nisarga Foundation in collaboration with various Government departments and voluntary organisations in the taluk and district. During the reporting period we had organized several programs such as Childline-1098 sub centre, Addressing Malnutrition through Spirulina nutrition supplement program, Nisarga Hadi Makkala Chiguru Shale (Community School) supported by Kluber Lubrication, Bangalore, Survey of recovery of learning loss across States supported by Azim Premji Development field research team, Adivasi Susthira Abhivruddhi Yojane supported by Azim Premji Philanthropic Initiatives(APPI). Nisarga Foundation's good association and relationship with the Taluk and District Department officials has resulted in regular contact and involvement of the govt officers in various programs of the organisation. This resulted in enhancing the credibility of the organisation.

VISION

MISSION

Our mission is to ensure positive socio-economic cultural and political empowerment in the indigenous, while protecting environment and nurturing its bio-diversity.

OBJECTIVES

Nisarga Foundation envisages overall development of Adivasis, Dalits and such of those socially and economically marginalized poor communities through measures of promotion of sustainable agriculture to ensure food security and livelihood, application of appropriate rural technologies, effective and judicious management of natural resources etc.

In the execution of these pro-poor projects, Nisarga Foundation embarks of action research-oriented projects of replaceable nature and builds the capacity of the communities to take charge of their own development through effective participation in the process of governance to be able to bring about changes in the policies suited to the well-being of themselves and their environment.

ORGANISATION STRENGTHS

It was fortunate enough for us to be a part of Niranthara program conducted by Dhvani Foundation, Bangalore which helped us in maintaining records related to Compliance and Governance. Today we have achieved 100% score in maintaining all the records such as Human Resource (HR) policy, Prevention of Sexual Harassment(POSH) policy, Child Protection Policy (CPP) have been implemented and strictly followed in the organisation. We are fortunate to have an experienced board of trustees and staff members who are the backbone of the organisation. The deep rooted knowledge and understanding of TRIBAL RIGHTS has helped us to promote and strengthen the Tribal community organizations, Budakattu Krushikara Sangha(BKS),Vanavasi Mahila Sangha(VMS) to address sustainability. The way Nisarga Foundation approaching tribal issues, has been noticed by the print and electronic media and received so many appreciation from media and society. To promote our ideologies and to fulfil organisational goals even more effectively NF has been using digital and print media such as website, Facebook, Twitter, Linked-In, YouTube and we are constantly active in using all these digital and print media.

In the year 2022-23, Nisarga Foundation was initially manned with strong Board of 06 members who were experienced in social works and dedicated professionals. NISARGA CHILDLINE SUB CENTER-1098

The Childline-1098 programme was established in the year 2010 as a sub-centre for Childline India Foundation, to ensure the safety of children in H D Kote, Hunsur and Periyapatna Taluk supported by Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India. We conduct regular Open House programmes for children, teachers, SHGs and community members, to build awareness about child rights, child labour, child marriage, education, POCSO Act 2012 and Child Helpline 1098. Youth Committees are formed and trained to address social challenges like child marriage, while children are empowered through Bala Panchayat and School Awareness Programmes.

Mass Awareness programmes:

During the year 2022-23, we conducted 09 Mass Awareness programmes. More than 3,415 people of all the communities from all the taluk of Hunsur, Periyapatna and H D Kote were given awareness on CHILDLINE 1098, Child Rights, POCSO Act, Child Marriage, Child trafficking and Child Labour Act. The awareness program was scheduled at Auto Stands, Bus Stand, Allied Departments, Women group, Anganwadi, and also at Gram Panchayat level, SHG groups, Schools and Colleges. The awareness program was conducted through orientation programs, distributing handbills, stickers and posters to the public. This program was received an overwhelming response from the public and they assured that they will support childline-1098 and its services during the case intervention.

Open House programmes:04 Open house programmes were conducted in H D Kote taluk for School Children, Teacher, Anganwadi workers, SHG members, Police, ACDPO, WCD, DCPU, SJPU, PDO, Doctors of PHC, SDMC Members Panchayat President & Members, Corporator, Government Officers,

Parents, VHSNC Members Auto & Tempo Drivers. As a result of the awareness programmes conducted children availed hygienic toilet in the school premises, cleanliness in and around the schools, bus problem is solved, child marriage rate was reduced, school dropouts were reduced, drinking water problem in school premises was resolved, in case of any problems children can expect an immediate response from the Police department. And many cases and problems were solved by the Police department.

Awareness programs: During the year 2022-23 an awareness on Childline-1098 were given to 20 SHGs, 109 schools, 27 Grama Panchayaths visit, 8 PHC's, 7 shops, and in 10 markets. 175 Asha workers, 14 police station consisting of 130 police staff. 138 Anganawadi workers took active participation in avoiding child marriages in and around the operational area of Childline, 56 tribal awareness consisting of 1895 people. 8 community awareness consisting of 340 people. 49 mothers meeting, 22 youth groups and 45 Children group were formed during the year 2022-23.

As a part of the program on 16th November 2022 Awareness on POCSO Act, CHILDLINE, JJ Act and child marriage act and Sports events conducted at Yarahally High School. Mr. Rasulla-SI, Purasabe Member, Lawyer, Teachers, Anganavadi worker, HM, CHILDLINE team members and others were present. Police sub inspector inaugurated the program and addressed the gathering. 140 children took part in the session.

On 17th November 2022 Public awareness conducted at Handpost circle. Handbills were distributed to 80 children and 760 Publics and posters were stuck in front of shops and on autos, shopkeepers, taxi stand, hotels, garages, pedestrians and general public places. On 18th conducted Child rights Gramasabha and Child friendly gramapanchayath Abhiyan program At Bheemanahally. PDO, GP president, GP members, HMs, Mr. Shivaraj from Jeevika NGO, teachers and CHILDLINE team members were participated in the program. On this occasion children jatha was conducted to awareness on child rights.

During the reporting period there is an increased the number of volunteers who actively called Childline-1098 and supported Childline team members. Due to lot of awareness about Childline in many schools and Grama Panchayath of H D Kote, Hunsuru, Periyapatna CHILDLINE wall paintings was visible. Childline sticker were pasted on bus, Auto and tempo. 12 runaway children were rescued and handed over to parents. We thank CHILDLINE India Foundation for their continued support.

CHIGURU SHALE (COMMUNITY SCHOOL)

About Nisarga Tribal children's Community School:

This school mainly creates an educational environment that provides value-based, quality education available and accessible to tribal society. Every human beings main urge is to think, learn, and act and express oneself freely and creatively. Keeping these objectives in mind Nisarga has stepped ahead in catering to the needs of Adivasi children and aimed at providing them a place of transformation through value-based education in collaboration with local Panchayath and Education Dept. Nisarga Foundation has voluntarily started the Nisarga Tribal children's school to cater to the educational needs of tribal children and promote tribal culture.

Nisarga Tribal Children's school is presently functioning in 4 tribal hamlets(Hadi) were 4 tribal volunteer teachers are educating the children (Masthigudi A Hadi, Masthigudi B Hadi, Annuru Hadi, Annuru chikkere Hadi). From 4 tribal hamlet 87 children are enrolled in our School and regularly attending the classes in the evening 5pm to 6.30pm. School functions on all working days. In this school we are providing education materials and cultural events support and small snacks for the children. We thank Kluber Lubrication, Bangalore for supporting Chiguru shale.

OUTCOMES OF CHIGURU SHALE:

1. There is a lot of improvement nutritional level in children; children are active and interested to learn new things. is increased.
2. Education level is improved. Children have learnt small words formation (2 words and 3 words). In mathematics children have taught tables (2-15) and simple addition, subtraction, multiplication is taught. Drawing, preparing clay models, craft work using locally available ingredients. Children can read and explain about the body parts chart, map of India, Kannada/English/Hindi Alphabets, Vegetables, flowers, animals and birds chart.
3. School dropout was reduced during this time. Students have developed leadership skills.
4. Parents are sending the children to school regularly.
5. Tribal culture, medicinal knowledge, folklore, traditional games and sports activities are improved in the children. Learning from forest, moral values and handling the situation was improved.
6. All the Volunteers teachers are teaching in their own tribal language. Tribal language Jenunudi, Bettakuruba, language is supported.
7. Special programs Gandhi Jayanthi celebrations, Independence Day, special festivals were celebrated at our Chirugu Shale.
8. Personal hygiene, nail cutting, taking bath every day, wearing washed clothes, hand wash before having food was improved in the children.
9. Leaders are emerging from this school.

10. Volunteers are coming forward to help Chiguru shale children.

Tribal volunteer teachers experience: We are very happy to work with Chiguru Shale. Earlier we were not recognized by Hadi people. After becoming Chiguru Shale teacher now we are invited for all the special events of the Hadi and recognized by Govt sector. We thank Nisarga Foundation for providing opportunity to work as volunteer teacher. With children we are also learning and improving.

We thank Mr. Prabhu N, who monitoring this program and training all our volunteer teachers in all the aspects of teaching and engaging the children in studies. We thank our donors Kluber Lubrication, Bangalore, and Mission Inde France for their valuable support to the education of the tribal children.

ADDRESSING MALNUTRITION IN INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY

To address malnutrition amongst tribal communities, N.F. launched the Spirulina supplement Nutrition Programme in 2014, supported by Mission Inde, France. We supplement the “home diet” of the target population with Spirulina nutritional capsules, which helps boost the growth of malnourished children and provides vital nutrients to pregnant women and lactating mothers. Dr Gerry Pais, Mysore, has been guiding and monitoring the SIRULINA programme. The programme has proven to be extremely beneficial in the last seven years and has been appreciated even by CFTRI (The Central Government Food and Research Institute), Mysore.

During the year 2022-23 16th and 17th phase of Spirulina Nutrition Supplement Program has been implemented in 11 Hadis consisting 110 beneficiaries. We assess all the children in the working area and identify malnourished children. We record the pregnant women and lactating mothers. We conduct awareness in the community, on the importance of Nutrition in the working areas. We explain the MERITS OF THE SPIRULINA SUPPLEMENT to overcome malnutrition and give a GOOD START to the children. For pregnant women, we further facilitate timely pre-natal check up, vaccinations for children, at the government health centres. We also monitor the health and nutritional needs of breast-feeding mothers. We encourage young mothers to avail periodic “Deworming Treatment” for their children. Public health and sanitation awareness programmes, training parents on food and nutrition, providing deworming tablets, and spreading awareness about government schemes, are some of our other health initiatives for indigenous communities.

At the start of 16th batch of Spirulina: Beneficiaries: 60 / Pregnant women: 8 / Lactating Mothers: 30 and 22 children. Out of the 22 children 1 child is having deficit of 5.2kgs, 16 Children were having deficit of more than 2 Kgs.

Results after 6 months:

Pregnant women: Out of 8 pregnant women 8 delivered during the reporting period. 3 children were born with normal birth weight. 5 children were born with below normal birth weight

Children & Lactating mothers: Out of 52 (LM and New Born) 24 have attained above normal weight of an increase from 100gms to 600gms compared to the ideal weight at the end of the six months. 17 children are having end- deficit below 1kgs.

ADIVASI SUSTHIRA ABHIVRUDDHI YOJANE

Adivasi Susthira Abhivruddi Yojana is a right based, community based project funded by Azim Premji Philanthropic Initiatives(APPI), Bangalore. The main aim of the project is to achieve 100% implementation of Forest Rights Act-2006, (Individual and Community rights) in 20 Hadis and make tribal people sustainable with the natural resources. To enable the tribals to understand their rights with awareness on Govt facilities, Schemes, Legal training, promoting sustainable harvest, enabling Grama Sabha and Forest Rights committee to function regularly, Capacity building of Grama Sabha, formation of Taluk Grama Sabha Vedike, followup and meeting with SDLC, DLC committee for obtaining IFR and CFR.

During the reporting period project is in the second and final year of the project. We have conducted Grama Sabha and FRC committee meeting regularly and awareness on Govt Scheme orientation and basic facilities training was given in 6 Hadi. During the reporting period legal training for the FRC committee members was organized in 4 Hadi. 5 Gramasabha capacity building training, 2 Sustainable harvesting training, 3 Taluk Adivasi Gramasabha meetings were conducted and 1 staff capacity building was conducted. Regular monthly review meetings were held during the reporting period. As a part of advocacy and lobby staff and co-ordinator visited SDLC, DLC officer as an when we required data on the implementation of the program.

Gramasabha:

Gramasabha was conducted regularly every month and through gramasabha many issues of hadi like water problems, road, alcoholism, tobacco usage, drainage cleaning, and sending the children to schools regularly were discussed and address the issues. 18 years completed individual members of Hadi will participate in the Gramasabha meeting and the problems are discussed and next steps were taken in the meeting. In Gramasabha local leaders and Gram panchayath members were participated and discussed in meeting and basic facilities were provided.

VFRC committee:

For this meeting Mr. Narayanaswamy, Tribal welfare officer, Mr. Ramaswamy, AD, Tribal welfare Dept, Mrs. Gayathri, Supervisor, tribal leaders from 20 hadi were present. Mainly discussed on the IFR and CFR application followup, houses under CCD Yojana, health camps, and at the end Mr. Prabhu discussed with leaders and decided for the unity of 120 tribal hadi leaders and conduct a next meeting at Nisarga.



Individual Forest Rights(IFR) and Community Forest Rights (CFR) application:

During the reporting period 804 Individual Forest Rights application has been submitted from 20 Hadi to the Grama panchayath. 12 Community Forest Rights application has been submitted from 12 Hadi. The applications are followed up with the GP and protest was done by Hadi people, escalated the same issues to the higher officers.

Impact of Susthira Abhivrudhi Yojane:

Before starting the Susthira Abhivrudhi project, Gramasabha's were not conducted in any Hadi. FRC committee was formed long back but it was not active, many of the members of Committee were not active and some were passed away. Youth is not interested in the Forest Rights, and had no hopes in getting their forest land. Leadership quality was diminished in youth and hadi people.

- The level of self confidence of each tribal has gone up after the establishment of VFRC in each haadi.
- All applications are filed through FRC committee only.
- Dispute re-addressable mechanism is operational in VFRC.
- Dependency on police station has drastically come down. Most of them depend on local redressal through VFRC. Alcohol and tobacco use is reduced in Hadis.
- Magnitude of harassment of non-tribal has come down drastically.
- Elections to Grama Panchayath was conducted and many of them elected as Grama Panchayath members.
- Community Participation has increased in Jatha, training, public functions.
- Local level network has been strengthened. Tribals participation in BKS, State level networking and National level networking is more.
- Tribals have acquired about 60% knowledge on FRA.
- Tribals have taken initiatives to go to forest and collect MFP, identify their borders, worship their traditional gods inside the forest. During April and May 2023, all the tribal from 15 hadis have gone to the forest and asserted their rights.
- Tribals have started developing a feeling of dignity about their own culture and values.

➤ Tribals have produced various food produce during the reporting period namely Ragi (95 quintals worth Rs.76000), maize (250 quintals worth Rs.12,50,000), pulses (18 quintals worth Rs.23,400), cotton (60 quintals worth Rs.1,80,000), paddy (25 quintals worth Rs.20000). It is an indicator of tribals moving towards food security.

Land cultivation: In Kakanakote forest region(Balle, Manimoole, Goluru, Kere Hadi, Bavali, Kere Hadi, Malada Hadi) tribal families are cultivating the land and tree based agriculture is done. In these Hadi IFR and CFR is received. They are growing coffee, pepper, Banana plant, yam, tapioca, turmeric, rice, etc. In forest fringe Hadi Jowar, Ragi and vegetables are grown. Outside the forest Hadi Majjanakuppe, Kunteri, Prabhanagara, Bheemanahalli they are cultivating ginger, jowar, tapioca, vegetables medicinal plants(Gail)

RECOVERY OF LEARNING LOSS ACROSS STATES STUDY

This study is a pan-India study on the status of recovery of learning loss among Government school children, with support from partner organizations.

Schools across India were closed for around two years since the lockdown in March 2020. Multiple studies and experiences of field-based organizations working in education have shown that there has been significant learning loss among children in foundational competencies in language and mathematics. Efforts are underway, by both government and non-government actors, to help children recover this learning loss before the curricular focus shifts to class-specific syllabus.

The main objective of this study would be to track recovery of learning loss due to school closure during the pandemic among government school children. The findings of the study are expected to be used for system-level advocacy to ensure that enough efforts (time, curricular changes, resources, and the right kind of learning recovery efforts) are dedicated by the central and state governments for recovery of foundational competencies before schools move back to their regular curricular routine.

In this study we had taken 8 districts across Karnataka and conducted an assessment across the state. Mysore, Mandya, Kodagu, Chamarajanagar from the south Karnataka, Gadag, Davanagere, Vijapur, Bagalakote districts were taken from North Karnataka. From each district 16 schools were selected and totally 122 schools were assessed. Focused on class 5 and class 8 on Kannada Language and Maths subject. All the assessment results were uploaded to system through Google form and Microsoft form. First assessment was conducted in the month of October and November 2022 and assessed 3526 students across Karnataka. Same schools were repeated for 2nd cycle on January & February 2023, assess 3336 students.

Training programs: Field research team of Azim Premji Foundation oriented the field assessors, supervisors, program managers and data entry operators on how to conduct assessment, purpose of study, Coding and data entry work in both the cycle at H D Kote and Gadag. This program has involved 2 program managers, 4 supervisors, and 64 field assessors to assess the children in 2 subjects from both class 5 and class 8. With the strong network support Nisarga Foundation was able to achieve the successful results in South as well as North Karnataka. Nisarga team is very happy to work with the field research team of APPI and we thank Mrs. Meera, Mr. Arif Hussain and Mr. Guru Moger for their continuous support and guidance.

Nisarga Foundation in association with NACDIP met 5 MP's of Karnataka for initiating a forum of "Child Friendly Legislators" to advocate for "Child Rights" as one of the critical agenda in the development plan of our country. Children are to be seen as our future in which we have responsibility in creating India as a safety zone for the next generation and requested MP's to be the ambassadors of the forum.
