

### ADDRESS

In this activity we have distributed we have distributed free roadside plants such as Neem, Tamarind, Gulmohar, etc. to avoid pollution and keep the area as pollution free zone. Under this program colony welfare association are involved and they have taken initiate to plant and pour water regularly. Nearly 50 people participated in this program. Our Secretary participated in this program Conducted in Warangal District.

#### **CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES:**

Under the head of this program we have conducted Cultural Program in rural areas of Warangal District. These cultural programs are conducted to create awareness about the traditions and culture in these areas. Nearly 25 people were participated and were benefited. We have also arranged folk songs as the communal choice for education of HIV/AIDS and STD'S. #### FREE COACHING FOR ADULT EDC:

In order to make adults, literate, our organization is running ten adult education centres in ten slums by arranging a teacher. In each centre we have about 30 to 35 adult learners who were taught to read and write. Our volunteers were provided with books from adult education centre of Warangal. Most of these learners are now able to read and write their names and are able to sign also. Apart from educate moral classes are also conducted to sensitize them on moral aspects. By this activity we are proud to say that many lives have been changed. We are also providing story books, picture and other informative charts to sensitize these learners.

#### **HIV PROGRAMME:**

Two days Training course have been organized on HIV/AIDS/STD. The purpose of this training course is to incullate awareness on HIV/AIDS/STD and protects youth as well as other persons from this killing disease. The Resource persons attended from local health centers and Govt Hospitals. They said that AIDS is only prevent but not curable. Hence other people particularly the young women and youth have to be changed the altitudes and stop to participate in inter-course with unknown persons. They said that

using up condoms get efforts in preventions of HIV/STD and other Health precautions to the participants. Some of the NGO'S explained how the HIV/AIDS is infected and affected people which are victimizing for death and how their family members are suffering. Hence it is everybody responsibility to creative awareness about the HIV/AIDS/STD and also prevent HIV/AIDS.150 young women and youth have been participated in this training course. They really enjoyed and realized the reason for HIV/AIDS/STD. Finally all the participants have promised that they have to make sincere efforts and prevent HIV/AIDS/STD.

The Awareness generation was created among the people in the above mentioned areas, about the HIV/Virus its effects and how to attacks HIV virus to the peoples couple and their children and advised the people to following principles.

- Use condoms compulsorily.
- Do not use unwashed syringes in the boiled water at time of injecting
- Do not go for illegal contacts

#### CHILD LABOUR PROGRAMME:

Our organisation conducted a survey, identified actual child labours, motivated the parents of such children and joined them at our child labour school.
