ANNUAL ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2017-18

SPANDANA EDUCATIONALSOCIAL AND CULTURAL ORGANISATION (R) is a registered organisation, registered under Karnataka Societies Act 1960 in office of District Registrar of Mandya Taluk of Mandya district and organization established a group of like-minded people to initiate various socio- economic, Educational, Vocational, Cultural, Health and Environmental activities for the welfare and the development of Rural and urban disadvantaged sections. The activities initiated by the organisation during the reporting period are as under.

1. WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME:

Women has a vital role in both family and community development and local government having different programme for women empowerment, but our rural women folk were not coming out from their family and society to understand the concept of the programme and its benefit towards women empowerment schemes like “Strishakthi” and women swavalambana programme in connection to that our organization has conducted women empowerment training programme for our organized self-help groups and Strishakthi women group members. The training programme was organized 2 days each from 21th to 22th February 2012 to 27th and 28th February 2018 at Sundahally and Bevanahally respectively. Totally 60 women group representatives were under gone this training, we were discussed issues like savings, selection of benefits, loan disbursement government shares and programme. Book-keeping and roles and responsibilities of women in family and community development. The total amounts spend for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs.75,680-00.

2. VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME:

It's not possible to provide a government job to each and every educated youth and women. To make such youth and women self reliable our organisation had conducted a vocational training programme in which both girls and boys were enrolled where tailoring, pickle making, doll making, welding, motor winding, electrical appliances repair etc training was given to make themselves self employed. The total amount spend for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs.1,10,500.00

3. DRUG ABUSE AND DE-ADDICATION PROGRAMME:

Our Organization is continued to conduct an awareness camp on drug abuse to control the drug addict in alcohol and drug abuse by our rural young community and this bad habit is spreading like anything in the rural area. This serious evil can be avoided through awareness. So organization conducted a mass education programme in project villages and some are the drug addicts were identified and sent to rehabilitation centre. Trust has spent an amount of Rs.11,975-00 for the year 2018.

4. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:

The Village of Hosahally is not having proper disposal solid work and due this conical diseases spreads to this local community not aware about organization has conducted a two days work shop on 15th January to 16th January 2018 at Hosahally rural area. Youth Members, SHG members and youth group members were participated in this programme

segregation in of waste in, 3 types like Dry, Green and Lazard waste and its proper disposal was the subjects were discussed. The total amount spend for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs.8,455-00.

5. WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:

Soil erosion was common in rural area and farmers were not aware about the watershed techniques and managements to control the soil erosion. So that organization is continuing efforts to control the soil erosion at maximum eater by creating awareness on this subject and constructing the check dam by local available resources. As a demonstration a check dam was constructed at Hemmge village of Mandya taluk with the help of local village community and village development association. The total amount spend for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs12,870-00

6. NON-FORMAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

Non-formal Education centers were regularly importing the literacy and have a better performance of the communities, especially in learning How to read and write and the Self-Help in the due course. The special emphasis in motivating the women towards establishing women Non-formal centers which will given much scope to establish more and more women non-formal centers in the project area. This programme was implementing in collaboration of Total literacy programme of Government of Karnataka. The total amount spend for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs.38,650-00

7. WOMEN LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMME:

The Prominent Village Leaders were offered an opportunity by getting trained to over come and resist exfoliation. To promote Social action with cohesiveness among the Target families. Focus was given to train the village leaders / Women group representatives in planning, implementation and management of local resources towards self-sustainability. By having this idea in mind organization has planned and conducted 2 training programme of 4 day each at Gejjalager and Budanur villages of Mandya taluk. The cluster village representatives were identified 68 villages leader both men and women and trained in the filed of unity, sharing the responsibilities in integrated rural development approach for their family and community. The total amount spends for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs.16,790.00.

8. RAIN HARVEST DEMO/TRAINING PROGRAMME:

The programme was continued in the reporting year due to rain is not receiving properly in these days and the scheduled of the rain keep on changing year by year due to the climatically changes in solar system and storage of the rain water is not taken place and all rainwater flowing out side, so keeping this in mind organization stared awareness programme in our project all project village through demonstration cum training programme The total amount spends for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs.10,360.00

9. LIBRAY PROGRAMME:

Providing library facilities to the local community is the main objective of the organisation because there is no such facility available in the town and most of the local communities were not having habit of reading day-to-day affairs and what is going around them. And most of dalith and minority community students are not having good facilities of library. So organisation continued the library programme during reporting year and facilitating both local communities and student community of our project area. The total amount spends for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs,15.480-00.

10. CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

It is necessary to inform the rural population who are unaware of the state and central Government programmes and the benefits of the schemes. The awareness programme is intend to make likely beneficiaries aware of their rights and enthuse local administration to play a more pro-active role, having this in mind the mass consumer awareness camps were organized in entire project area through public meetings, functions and group discussions a special awareness is given to the rural women to ensure the steps while purchasing the essential the domestic goods. The total amounts spend for this programme for the year 2018 is Rs.22,750-00.

EVALUVATION OF THE PROGRAMS:

Usually evaluation was done quarterly, half yearly and at the end of the year through our field staff and experts from out side, by involving community. Apart from these evaluations a separate evaluation was conducted at end of each activity. Focus will also be made to motivate the community to approach Financial Institutions, Government department, political bodies and other agencies to meet the infrastructures and developmental requirements of their activities for the total Socio-Economic development of the target group families in particular and community as a hole.
