This Program mainly focus on the Child Labor rehabilitation program, NFE and Pre School, under the Ministry of Labor and Employment Government of India and Karnataka. The Deputy Commissioner of Bangalore Rural District has sanctioned us this school for 50 Child Labors. Bridge course is given for the Children for one year to two years. This year we have enrolled 08 children sent to main stream school after their successful completion of two years bridge course. Under the State Child labor Program (SCLP) residential facilities given to the children with Nutritious food and Good Hostel Facilities.


