

A few clients who received Counseling Service along with Shelter home service like *Shagila, Vinnarasi, Ruby, Sangeeta, Asaa, Nisha, Philo, Raja, Vinitha, Arulmozhi, Soundharya, Saloni, Arunmozhi, etc.,* The most common feature is their vulnerability is to yield to the honey words of the victimizers and surrender without any family support. All of them are counseled and given assistance legally and morally to lead a courageous life and post counseling assistance is also ensured.

## 5-day camp in Ranipet ends, MCC students submit report



The Bsc Social Work students focused on the marginalised groups, including those from Boom Boom Mattukaran and Jaati Kaara communities, domestic violence victims, and Sri Lankan refugees.

The primary objective of the camp was to gain insights into the challenges faced by these communities and assess their basic necessities. After thorough observation and interaction, they prepared a comprehensive report highlighting the vulnerabilities and needs of the communities. On Tuesday, the report was officially submitted to Ranipet Collector S Valarmathi, calling for urgent attention of officials.
