WOMEN'S RIGHTS ARE THE FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS

It is now said that "women's rights are human rights." Yet, women in rural areas are seldom aware about these rights. Thus, to spread awareness about these rights, we undertook an awareness training programme to the women of Aathithai Women Livelihood Protection Movement in Thendral Movement. Our 3 staff members aimed to educate Women Panchayath Level leaders and Block Coordinators in the office of Thendral Movement. We were able to reach out to 40 women and educate them about their rights.
