

#### WOMEN EMPOWERMENT:

Women from marginalized communities, widows, and single mothers are very often excluded from availing the livelihood opportunities in society, abused by patriarchy, and restrained from exercising their basic rights. We coordinate with the government and other like-minded



organizations in reaching these target communities and provide solutions based on the problems they face through networking, guidance, formation of SHGs, Village Women Councils, family counselling, women forum, income generation activities, legal justice, care for victims, and awareness generation for their rights. Our overall aim is to promote gender equality, behavioural changes, improve their standard of living, social security, and reduce suicide and divorce rates.

#### **CHILD and YOUTH DEVELOPMENT:**

Our target communities are slum & rural school children, adolescent girls, youth girls and boys, Transgender and physically challenged. We help these communities through issue-based interventions, and they are:



#### HEALTH AND AWARENESS:

Health is an important aspect of our work. We try to promote the health of the communities through different approaches. We have S4S Club (Awareness on self-defense, fitness of the body, healthy food habits, and girl children physical abuse) and Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM) programme for children and adolescent girls. We conduct awareness generation programmes on cancer, HIV+, irregular menstrual cycle, importance ofmother's feeding the infant baby, utilizing healthy sanitary pads for women. We also conduct workshops for women where experts in the health areas give awareness to the women. Additionally, we also provide homemade Health Mix "Hello Breakfast" nutritious flour for weak and anaemic women and Children.

#### **RESCUE AND REHABILITATION:**

We have a special infrastructure for our various programmes to rescue and rehabilitate women, children and youth. We provide a Short Stay home, a counselling center, training centre and crèche centers to rehabilitate victimized communities.

# COVID19 RELIEF ACTIVITIES FOR MIGRANT WORKERS, RELEASED BONDED LABOURERS, WIDOWS & PSYCHO-SOCIAL COUNSELLING TO THE DECEASED FAMILIES DUE TO COVID19

**PANDEMIC:** 

**Outbreak of COVID-19** pandemic in 2020 has severely affected the lives and livelihood of many people. Series of lock down curfew have economically impacted the underprivileged and disadvantaged communities. We sensed the need to uplift the downtrodden, so we advocated the crisis to our friends, well-wishers and generousdonors to begin our COVID relief support activism. In the month of April 2021, many like-minded organizations



and individuals supported both financially and materially for the noble cause of feeding and providing the Raw Ration to the poor, widows, migrant workers, and destitute women. Thendral Movement has already been working forthe empowerment of women in Five slums viz., (Karai, Merkku Cotton Bazzar, Railway station Colony, Srinivasanpet, Padma Colony). So we have identified 101 families headed by single women & widows and supplied them basic foodMaterials like food raw ration materials like, *Rice, Dhall, Masala, Edible oil, Biscuits and Rava*. 14.10.2021 we distributed the food materials to the needy women. Our Founder Dr. P. Vedhanayagi and Rev. Joy Devakani from Germany had been with us in this event. Psych-Socio Counselling was provided to 331 families who lost their breadwinner. The donor & beneficiary meet doubled the joy of the beneficiaries because of her meaningful gesture and comforting words. Our women staff and Aathithai Women Livelihood Movement – the women wing of Thendral Organization were actively involved in this relief task which made ourreach outs much effective. Our special thanks to friends and well-wishers whoare prime supporters.

#### DAY CARE ASSISTANCE TO 125 CHILDREN THROUGH NATIONAL CRÈCHE SCHEME:

Thendral has been in the day care assistance service through the National Crèche Scheme since the year 2013. After the relax of the COVID - 19 pandemic crisis rules, from 15<sup>th</sup> September year 2021 we have been nurturing children on all aspects. During the pandemic, we have been providing the families of the children with essential counselling pertaining to safety measures followed in this tough days.

# AWARENESS GENERATION & OBSERVATION OF THE ABOLITION OF CHILD LABOR SYSTEM DAY WITH 300+ CHILDREN AND WOMEN:

Abolition of Bonded Labour System Day 09.02.2022 was observed by the women gathered in Arcot Union in Ranipet district. They pledged to make Tamil Nadu a state free of bonded labour slavery. Dr P.Vedhanayagi, the founder of the Organization & member of the monitoring committee for the abolition of slavery in Ranipet district, Mr.Thanikesan Social activist, Mrs.Amudha S, coordinator of Staff of Women Livelihood Aathithai



Movement, Mrs.Saranya – the field coordinator and S4S club coordinator along with more than 60 panchayat women leaders participated and created awareness among the public. #### FAMILY COUNSELLING SERVICE:

We give family counselling to the violence-affected women and other needy persons who approach us from the various life circumstances.



Our approach helps many women to come out of their suicidal mind set, and empower them to take positive decisions with their life. They get their family reconciled with them and for the welfare of the children the victim & Victimizer are well-counseled to abide by each other's betrothal vows.

#### CHILD MARRIAGE RESCUE ISSUE RESOLVED:

On 23.11.2021 THENDRAL Movement received information regarding the Child Marriage Issue held in Ayilam village in Arcot block. The Victim Mrs.Savitha(15) who was harassed by her Grand Father was immediately rescued and enquired about the incident. She was





comforted. We arranged for the Family Counselling session and explained the Child Marriage Act. The victimizer (her husband) was called for and warned him. We advised the grandmother of the victim to take care of her at home. We arranged for her to continue her School studies in SSLC. It was advised that she will be in her Mother's house until she is 21 years passed. Meanwhile, she completed her SSLC and with overwhelming joy lives her childhood at her native.


