ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES

PLANTATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Balrampur Distric of UttarPradesh State. To stop illegal plant cutting and balancing environment our society started environment awareness programme. Under plantation programme our society working trees re-plantation for minimize bad effect due to



pollution. Our society also focused and working for to control sound pollution and water pollution. Our society tried to give massage in the people for planting in their birthday ceremony to celebrate. Our organization successfully planted trees of various verities such as Amrapali, Maldah, Bombay, Kalkatia, in fruits and Neem, Jammun, Banana, litchi, Kathal and other more verities of public utility trees.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Balrampur District of UttarPradesh State. Economic empowerment is a sine qua non for elevating the status of women in our society. One possible approach towards achieving this end could be through entrepreneurship development. Through entrepreneurship development a women will not only generate income for herself but also generate employment for other women in the locality. This will have a multiplier effect in the generation of income and poverty alleviation. According to society



many causes of poverty in India and which main causes are poor status of women, less job opportunity & low productivity and low income are make vicious circle of poverty.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Balrampur District UttarPradesh State. In the

present situation, we have been able to create everybody in rural areas but so far as their services delivery is concerned, majority of them are not up to the mark. There is a need to revitalize and strengthen the already existing bodies in rural areas rather than putting a thrust on creating more and more institutions. Every rural development programme should be carried



out with the association and involvement of the community people.

BLOOD DONATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Balrampur District of Bihar State. Blood donations in India are conducted by several organizations and hospitals by organizing blood donation camps. Donors can also visit blood banks in hospitals to donate blood or directly to a receiver. Despite shortage of donated blood, efforts by the government and various organizations have led to a decrease in the demand and supply gap over the years. The number of voluntary blood donors increased from 54.4% in 2006–2007 to 83.1% in 2011–2012, with the number of blood units



increasing from 4.4 million units in 2006–2007 to 9.3 million units in 2012–2013. In 2016, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare reported a donation of 10.9 million units against a requirement of 12 million units. Blood donors in India donate around 350 millilitres of blood. After a donation, the donors are provided with refreshments, which usually include a glucose drink, biscuits and fruits. Some organizations offer transportation facilities, apart from providing certificates or badges as a gratitude.

<u>HIV/AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME</u>

The organisation conducted the programme in Balrampur District of UttarPradesh State. India is sitting on an HIV/AIDS "time-bomb". This is the warning from the head of an international survey agency. "The HIV/AIDS deadly disease in India is extremely grave. It is ticking time bomb. The epidemic is rising rapidly and could soon get out of control, unless the response was scaled up massively." In Bihar, for instance, no one knows how many persons are affected. OUR



Organisation accepted the need participating of community and social workers for minimize this problem. Without participating and involvement of the corporate sector, the NGOs and community-based organizations the Government would not be able to tackle the problem all by itself and more effectively in anti-AIDS programmes. Our organisation practices to awareness people about HIV/AIDS through print & tele media and own health care center, but not proper success to attain. A majority of the male respondents indicated progresses for female method. They did not prefer the male methods mainly because of the fear of weakness due to the was of male method, fear of method failure and fear of operation It was decided to prepare a wide AIDS scheme for the coverage of family planning Programme by the society. Local doctors and Para-medical



workers have extended their useful co-operation in diffusion of the requisite knowledge about family planes methods to the eligible couples with intrusive comparing in the district.

WOMEN & CHILD WELFARE PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Balrampur District of UttarPradesh State. With support of UNICEF Gopalganj, SOCIETY started programme for women and children rights. In this programme our society organize meeting and seminars to intervene and give knowledge about women and children rights given by law. In this intervention & training programme about 50 youths benefited and trained organized by our society. Under this second stage meeting and seminars trained youths were teach uneducated women about



law & rights. SOCIETY under this programme also teaches law & rights of child, specially focused on the topic of child labour. It was observed that in polio-vaccination day, Hepatitis-B etc. There was mass gathering on the day. As the people of rural area, have poor knowledge of legal rights and solution, the people should be attracted and according Legal-cum-Health Mela is being proposed to organise.

DRUG-ABUSE PREVENTION

The organisation conducted the programme in Balrampur District of UttarPradesh State. Drug abuse prevention begins with education, spreading the word regarding the dangers of drugs to oneself and to the community. These programs are just the beginning. The information provided is most effective when it is followed up with continued support. Drug prevention programs

FARMER TRAINING PROGRAMME
